

Instructions for drivers

The Aarau terminal has adopted a series of anti-contagion measures in compliance with current regulations. Drivers are required to strictly observe the below instructions.

- 1. Access to the terminal is forbidden to people with fever symptoms or who have come into contact with people infected by coronavirus
- 2. Wear personal protective equipment (e.g. mask, gloves) provided by your company
- 3. When entering the terminal and during the operation of check-in/delivery and pick-up of the unit, the driver must <u>always</u> remain in his cab
- 4. Keep a distance of at least 2 meters from all other people
- 5. Use the gloves and disinfectant material at your disposal
- 6. Entrance to the counter is allowed to a max. of 1 person at a time
- 7. Access to restrooms and/or vending machines is allowed to a max. of 1 person at a time
- 8. The signs (including ground signs) and instructions given by Hupac personnel must be strictly observed
- 9. We remind you that it is absolutely forbidden to take photographs or video footage.

COVID-19 - Behaviors to follow



Often wash your hands

with soap and water or alcohol-based hand rub



Avoid contact with people suffering from respiratory infections

Keep at least 2 meters away



Avoid touching eyes, nose or mouth with your hands



Cover mouth and nose if you sneeze or cough

Cough or sneeze in a tissue or, if not available, in the elbow crease



Avoid crowded places

e.g. sports events or public transport



Clean surfaces with chlorine or alcohol-based disinfectants



Follow the instructions and recommendations locally provided
